WHEN JESUS CAME TO CHURCH – In November, we completed a study of Revelation 1-3. These are timeless lessons in letter form that Jesus dictated to John to help churches of all times and places to determine where they stand and what they need. There was a pattern for the letters. And each letter concludes with an invitation: **"To the one who overcomes....**" In spite of what we undergo, it's nice to know we can overcome! You can be a winner if you follow the will of God!

Then in **Revelation 2-3** he calls each church to a particular trait. (All churches need every trait all the time, but not all churches lack each trait at the same time.) He calls on the churches to have: LOVE (Ephesus), FAITHFULNESS (Smyrna), PURITY (Pergamun), DISCERNMENT (Thyatira), OBEDIENCE (Sardis), ENDURANCE (Philadelphia), and DEPENDENCE (Laodicea).

That's what he says when Jesus comes to church!

CHRISTMAS STORIES - In December, we used cultural traditional stories to springboard into timeless biblical Christmas stories. HOW THE GRINCHES STOLE CHRISTMAS utilized the character by that name and was a challenge to not let the traditions of the culture steal the real meaning of Christmas for you. THE ULTIMATE CHRISTMAS TREE utilized A Charlie Brown Christmas and the fact that the cross was the destiny of the Christ child from before he even occupied the manger. SCROOGE AND OTHER VILLIANS utilized the famous Dickens character and reviewed prominent Scrooge attitudes in history including the Serpent Satan, the Rebel Rulers, and Horrid Herod. A HALLMARK CHRISTMAS utilized the stories that Hallmark cranks out each year to point out that the true Christmas was much more than a sentimental story. We hope you have received the wonderful life of hope, peace, love and joy found only in Jesus!

HERE WE GROW AGAIN - In January, we will study from the Biblical writings of Rocky Johnson. Who is he and what is he doing in my Bible? Come in (or tune in) on January 2nd to find out! The encouragement to grow is a message that every church needs to hear in a new year – especially a church in transition!

COMEBACK CHARACTERS - Beginning in February, we will turn our attention to the Gospels to consider the TOP TEN COMEBACK CHARACTERS IN THE LIFE OF CHRIST. Who are they? We will reveal a new one each week. We will end on Easter with the greatest comeback character of all – the risen Christ!

BIBLE TIME - On January 3rd, we will begin 89 DAYS WITH JESUS. It is a reading plan designed to take us through all four of Jesus' authorized biographies – also known as the Gospels – in 89 days (one chapter a day for 6 days a week) from the first of the year through Resurrection Sunday. If you don't already have a Bible Time plan, you are invited to join us as we spend 89 DAYS WITH JESUS!
