Will you join us as we ride this wave of momentum together?


We're praying that everyone who calls MPC home will participate.

First worship service held, congregation established, and initial ministries launched with construction of our facility at 11844 Mandarin Road.

1980-1994 Expansion & Development

Continued growth led to construction of a new sanctuary, educational facility (Woody's), expanded classrooms, modern kitchen, and larger fellowship hall.

1995-2020 Strategic Growth & Campus Expansion

Expanded facilities with acquisition of additional property on Loretto Road and riverfront property. This growth established our two primary campuses: our Office Campus, which houses our preschool and fellowship spaces, and our Church Campus for worship services and Sunday school.

2025 Our Next Chapter

Launch Momentum initiative to enhance our campuses, making room for more people to move toward Jesus by expanding Next Gen Ministry, Community & Connection, Bible study, Outreach and more.

The Generosity Journey is a tool designed to help you focus on your giving and be increasingly intentional about it. This journey focuses on the behavior and attitudes of our hearts.

Each step of the journey represents growth in a lifestyle of generosity and sacrifice. These are not steps to get you closer to God, but steps to help you mature in generosity to be like Him.

Where are you in your generosity journey?

CONSISTENT GIVER

2 CORINTHIANS 9:6-8

A Consistent Giver is someone who decides to give something and gives it regularly to exercise the discipline of giving steadily. Often, someone who decides to make their gift an online recurring gift will be learning the behavior of consistency.

SACRIFICIAL GIVER

COLOSSIANS 1:15-18, 22-23

A Sacrificial Giver is someone who recognizes the cost Christ paid on the cross for us and is honoring God with 100% of their resources as a result. A Sacrificial Giver gives in a way that changes them. Their giving governs their spending and saving rather than their spending and saving governing their giving. They seek to honor God with 100% of what he has given them, whether direct monetary giving or a God honoring use of an existing resource like a home or vehicle.

A Lifetime Giver

LUKE 14:28-35

An Intentional Giver is someone who begins to think about making their giving a deliberate choice that redirects how they prioritize their spending. This may be the moment when someone begins to tithe, committing a defined share toward a certain amount or percentage they want to give to God.

INTENTIONAL GIVER

LIFETIME GIVER

1 TIMOTHY 6:6-19

A Lifetime Giver is someone who thinks about the long-term effects of the generosity rather than month-to-month or even year-to-year generosity. A Lifetime Giver makes decisions in the short term to have long-term effects as it relates to their generosity capacity.

What could be your next step?

FIRST-TIME GIVER 2 CORINTHIANS 8:7-15

A First-Time Giver is someone who decides to give for the first time out of a response to God's Word about giving.

Insights to inspire your reading of **Nehemiah**

- Repopulated Jerusalem

Nehemiah has 13 chapters and is the 16th book of the Old Testament.



In the Hebrew Bible, Nehemiah was originally combined with Ezra.





Jerusalem was located in Judea which was a province of the Persian Empire from 539-332 BC.



Nehemiah ends Old Testament history—about 400 years before Christ's birth.

"Nehemiah" He led Jerusalem means Comfort of for 14 years (444-432 BC). Yahweh. He was cupbearer to King Artaxerxes (465-424 BC).

READ



Nehemiah 1:1-2:10

BIG IDEI



Nehemiah's memoir begins with news of the humiliating condition of Jerusalem. His instinctive reaction is prayer. The first step in all circumstances, whether significant or insignificant, is to align our hearts with God's in prayer.

KEY VERSE



Nehemiah 1:4

"When I heard these things, I sat down and wept. For some days I mourned and fasted and prayed before the God of heaven."

READ



Nehemiah 2:11-2:20

Nehemiah 2:17-18

BIG IDE



Upon arrival in Jerusalem, Nehemiah surveys the wreckage around the city under the cloak of night, and gives a reality check to the leaders. Momentum requires an honest assessment of the current situation and a willingness of everyone to take ownership.

EY VERSE



"'...Come, let us rebuild the wall of Jerusalem, and we will no longer be in disgrace.' I also told them about the gracious hand of my God on me and what the king had said to me."

READ



Nehemiah 4

Ephesians 6:10-11

BIG IDEI



God's servants must always be ready both to serve in kingdom work and to fight against Satan's strategies to discourage and divide.

KEY VERSE



"Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes."



Week 4 November 2-8 Integrity





READ



Nehemiah 5:1-7:3

Isaiah 1:16-17

BIG IDEA



In addition to external enemies, there was also internal conflict among the Jews. Following God's vision not only requires achieving the end goal but also doing it in a way that honors God and is faithful to His character.

KEY VERSE



"Wash and make yourselves clean. Take your evil deeds out of my sight; stop doing wrong. Learn to do right; seek justice. Defend the oppressed. Take up the cause of the fatherless; plead the case of the widow."



Week 5 November 9-15 Joy



READ



Nehemiah 8:1-18

BIG IDEA



As the Jews prepare for a reformation they begin by gathering around God's Word and remembering with joy God's faithfulness to His people.

KEY VERSE



Nehemiah 8:10

"...This day is holy to our Lord. Do not grieve, for the joy of the LORD is your strength."





Week 6 November 16-22 Confession and Covenant



READ



Nehemiah 9:1-10:39

BIG IDEA



True repentance requires two steps:

- Confession ownership of our own brokenness and where we have fallen short of God's standard
- 2. Covenant a firm commitment to do things differently, to do things God's way instead of our way.

KEY VERSI



Psalm 51:10

"Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me."



Neek 7 November 23-29 Dedication and Follow-through



READ



Nehemiah 12:27-13:31

BIG IDE



God's people celebrate the completion of the wall with great joy and fanfare, but in less than half a generation they lose their way again. In our relationship with God every day is an opportunity to recommit ourselves to following Jesus and surrendering to His Spirit.

KEY VERSE



Hebrews 12:1-2

"Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith."





Questions & Answers

What is Momentum?

Momentum is a God-sent, God-sized vision for MPC. It's a 25-month journey of sacrificial giving designed to expand our ministry to create room for more people to move toward Jesus. By making this commitment together, MPC will be able to expand and enhance our campuses to fulfill our mission in Jacksonville and beyond.

What if I'm new around here?

Thank you for being a part of MPC! Momentum is an invitation for everyone at MPC. It's about the vision for our church and our personal discipleship in giving as followers of Jesus. In 2 Corinthians 8:6, the apostle Paul calls giving an "act of grace." We believe that the local church is one of the most compelling and strategic missions to give toward. If you're ready for it, this is a perfect time to make MPC your home and join us in this Momentum initiative.

What does it mean for my Momentum commitment if I'm on a limited income?

Momentum is about your sacrificial generosity to God's mission. God calls us to action in times of hardship just as much as he does in times of abundance. That looks different for every person. We believe God will provide for you as you seek ways to sacrifice and work toward a generous commitment—whatever that means for you. Regardless, we'll all be supporting, loving, encouraging and praying for one another through this spiritually stretching season at MPC.

What will be asked of me?

First and foremost, we're asking everyone to pray. Spend time in personal reflection with God. Pray for God's guidance. Pray for God to use MPC to impact our community in a profound way. Pray about how He wants you to be involved. Momentum will challenge each family to make a sacrificial 25-month commitment that goes beyond regular giving.

Can I contribute to the Initiative without making a commitment?

Of course. But sacrificial giving requires a commitment. We're not asking for equal gifts, but equal sacrifice. Therefore, it's important for you to make a formal commitment by turning in a Commitment Card.

Why should I give to Momentum?

At MPC, we're not about growing numbers. We're about moving more people toward Jesus. Only through Jesus can we have freedom, hope and purpose. By helping us expand our ministry capacity, you make room for more people to move toward Jesus—including those who have yet to come—and create an impact for eternity.

Can I give to Momentum in ways other than cash?

Yes! There are many creative ways you and your family can participate. Gifts may include stocks, bonds, mutual funds, investment property, real estate, or even collectibles. Personal items of lasting value, such as vehicles, boats, or jewelry, may also be considered. If you'd like help with facilitating a gift of property or stock, we're here to assist you.
