Weekly distributions steadily increased in 2024 and now averages 65 households impacting more than 170 individuals with 20+ weekly guests taking advantage of the Clothes Closet. These include canned goods, packaged dry goods, bread & pastries, fresh fruits & vegetables, as well as dairy products. Occasionally, meat, fish, and poultry items are also available.


