

High School Mission Camp Generate (Mt. Vernon, Georgia) June 9-13, 2025



Trip Cost: \$300 (This is the individual share of the \$555 total/person)

*Students attending the Georgia trip and another trip have 2 payment choices. They can pay the Georgia trip in full (\$555) or can double the student mulch requirement (using family members) to receive the \$300 price.

This summer we are offering THREE unique mission/serve experiences – in Costa Rica, Georgia, and Jamaica. We encourage you to look at each trip, pray, and consider which one God may be leading you to be a part of. We understand there are many motivations behind why you may choose a specific trip (friends, adventure, service hours, desire to grow deeper with God, wanting to serve significantly) the list could go on! **These trips are first and most importantly about what God is doing in our world and how we can join that and support ministry partners in Georgia, Costa Rica, and Jamaica.**

*Georgia is a great first step mission experience that combines a traditional camp/conference with service. This is a great trip for students that want to serve within the US and for students who are wanting to serve multiple weeks in their summer (combo with another trip).

*Costa Rica is a great first international mission trip for students who want to travel overseas and be part of God's global work. We have partnered with 6:8 ministries doing trips for over 15 years and have long standing relationships with their staff. This trip will allow students to serve with US missionaries, interact with Costa Rican children and adults, and volunteer on a work project that benefits the local community.

*Jamaica is our Next Level trip for 2025. This trip is open to students who have served on an international mission trip before (with MPC or other organization). This trip is intended to further challenge students to learn about culture and ministry work in a new context, to take steps out of their comfort zones and to engage in global service. Experience Mission is an organization we have partnered with before to facilitate a Next Level trip.

Trip Description:

We will be traveling to Mt. Vernon, Georgia to serve with local ministry organizations. We will be staying at Brewton-Parker College as part of Generate's Mission Camp experience. Mornings and evenings we will participate in worship with other churches, then in the afternoons we will be doing projects in the community. In past years, groups have done home repair, led kid's clubs, visited seniors, and helped individuals with special needs. Exact projects will be determined closer to the trip.

Who should Apply:

- High School students who have prayed about this trip and feel God leading them to this team.
- Students who are willing to set aside their personal comforts and fully participate in all aspects of the week. This trip includes physically challenging work, relational connection, community engagement, and spiritual growth.
- Students who will have a great attitude at all times and who will be open to what God is doing.

***Note: Students on this trip will only be allowed to bring cell phones for use on travel days. Phones will be kept by leaders and locked in rooms. MPC is not responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen phones. Parents will have emergency numbers, and we will post daily updates on a private Facebook page.**

Dates and Requirements:

For everything to run smoothly and to offset trip costs we need the following from team members and their families – (these are NOT optional):

Team Members:

- ❖ **Complete application** and turn in a \$50 non-refundable deposit by Sunday, January 26! (Anyone not selected for this year's team or put on waitlist will have their total deposit refunded)
- ❖ **Attend Parent/Student Meeting: February 23 from 2-3pm at the Mandarin Road Campus ***Save this date*****
- ❖ **Help sell mulch** to family and friends and distribute flyers in neighborhoods - we are asking each participant to have a goal of at least 10 orders from family/neighbors outside of the church
- ❖ **Help with spreading mulch** on 4 of these 6 dates: March 15, 22, 29 and April 5, 12, 19.
*If you do not complete 4 spread days, \$75 will be added to your balance for each missed day. You can have a parent or another person work for you if needed.
 - ***Mulch days are from 8am – 5pm. Students are responsible for being there the entire time OR getting someone to come fill in their spot if they have to leave early/arrive late.**
 - ***At least one of your four days needs to be April 12 or 19 as these are our two biggest weeks!**
- ❖ **Pay remaining deposits:** \$250 by April 12.
- ❖ **Participate in Crave or Wed. Bible Study *at least twice a month.*** (It is important to be connected with peers and growing in faith year round – not just on trips!)
- ❖ **Attend Training Days**
 - Training: Sunday, April 27 from 2-3:30pm
- ❖ **Commissioning Service:** Sunday, June 8 at the 10:30am Worship Service
- ❖ **Actual Mission Trip:** June 9-13
- ❖ **Team Worship Rehearsal:** Saturday, July 19 from 9am – noon
- ❖ **Sharing Worship Service: Sunday, July 20 at the 10am service**

Parents (or an adult in family):

- ❖ **Attend Parent/Student Meeting:** February 23 from 2:30-3:30pm at the Mandarin Road Campus
- ❖ Sign up for at least **2 days of the following** (Signup Genius)
 - Selling mulch at the tent on Saturdays on Mulch spread dates
 - Mulch Deliveries – Every Thursday and Friday before spread dates (or other day as available)
 - Drive and spread on mulch Saturdays
- ❖ **Make sure your child is available to attend and fulfill all of the listed requirements and that payments are made at the designated times.**

Note: You will need to type your answers into the online form. We are giving you the questions here so that you have time to prepare.

Applications will be accepted starting at 10am on January 1 through midnight on January 26.

Deposits are due January 26 to hold your application. We will notify everyone of team selection no later than February 5, 2025. We will deposit checks at the time of team announcements. Anyone not selected for a team or waitlisted will have their deposits returned.

FUNDRAISING

Mulch is the main fundraiser for this trip and is the only way we can offer participants the discounted trip cost. Even if you could pay the trip cost, many others cannot. We couldn't pull it off and assist others without everyone's efforts – that is why it is a requirement. We will be taking orders and then doing all deliveries and spreading over a 6-week window of time. Participants will choose 4 of the 6 spreading Saturdays to work. See dates and requirements page for details.

In addition to mulch, team members have the option to sell TPC tickets and keep \$40 per ticket sold for their trip cost. We will also give you a sample letter that can be sent out to family and friends if you would like to raise money that way. *TPC tickets can be sold immediately – you do not need to wait for team selection.
