# S.C.A.M.P.

During the week of July 10-14, MPC Kids Ministry hosted SCAMP (Summer Camp at Mandarin Presbyterian) which is our version of VBS. The ministry saw God work in numerous ways as He allowed the church to host 323 children aged 4 years through rising 6th graders. The regular SCAMP program ran 9am-noon at both the Mandarin Road and Loretto Road campuses. The program also included an extended day portion that provided summer camp for 78 campers that lasted until 5:30pm each day!

It took 153 volunteers and many hours of preparation, study, and decoration to make this amazing week happen. Because of all the work and effort of so many MPC volunteers, kids had the opportunity to sing songs, playwild games, eat delicious snacks, and experience engaging Bible lessons, all pointing them to "Shine Jesus Light," which they repeated often all week long!



# **Update from the Daily Bread Food Pantry**



uest visitation to our MPC Daily Bread Food Pantry and Clothes Closet remains strong and consistent, with a recent uptick. On average, through the first six months of 2023, our seventy or so faithful volunteers have contributed to the weekly distribution of three grocery bags full of canned and packaged products along with breads and pastries, fresh fruit, vegetables, and dairy products. Weekly distribution has averaged just over 52 households (more than 125 individuals). Additionally, over 21 guests each week (70+ monthly) have taken advantage of a vast array of items from the Clothes Closet! We at MPC are truly blessed to be a blessing to those in our community that need food and clothing assistance!

The steady flow of miscellaneous donated dry goods remains the primary need. Recent increases in donations of good old BROWN PAPER grocery bags (we use 160+ per week) have helped GREATLY! Please keep them coming!! Our Clothes Closet remains in need of a steady flow of clothing donations of ALL kinds. In

particular: women's dresses and blouses/tops, children's clothes (all ages) and men's shirts and pants. Donations of all goods may be placed in the marked Food Pantry bins at the main sanctuary or church offices. Congregationwide, steady food donations have served to stoke the fires of the Daily Bread Food Pantry (Ministry) for over 10 years!! Start thinking BOGO for the Pantry!! Better yet: B-O-G-O-D-O .... Buy – One – Get – One – Donate - One!! Everyone can participate, every week!!!

Lastly, we appreciate and are grateful for your prayers for this ministry and our guests, as we continue stepping and marching toward Jesus in support of our neighbors in need. God has truly shown his light on this ministry, and the love and support our congregant partners have consistently given since our first day has enabled us to be a positive provisioner in our community.


