

### Dear Students and Parents:

At MPC our goal is to help all generations take their next step towards a deeper relationship with Jesus Christ. We are excited to invite your student to do this in an intentional way through a program called NEXT! NEXT is an experience for  $7^{th} - 12^{th}$  graders that takes a deep dive into faith, the church and what it means to be a follower of Jesus.

This year we will offer 3 different segments/experiences, each with a unique focus. Students who would like to become members at MPC will be required to complete all 3 segments (see notes on Confirmation below); students who do not wish to join MPC can choose to participate in as many as they choose.

NEXT will give students opportunities to learn the big story of scripture; study the Bible, develop their understanding of worship, and experience spiritual disciplines. We will hear stories of faith and write our own Statements of Faith as part of our time together!

\*Note: One class day can be missed during each segment.

**NEXT Weekend (MS)** – April 10-12. This is a discipleship focused retreat for any 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> grader (friends welcome). Cost is \$150.

To join, they must complete all 3 segments, give their Statement of Faith, and be baptized (if they haven't already). The decision to become a member is a meaningful one and needs to be made by each student themselves (not required by parents).
