
Part of our commitment to faith is through our financial giving. We hope you'll be moved to pledge your commitment to our church for the coming year.

Our dedicated volunteers continue their weekly distribution of three grocery bags filled with a variety of items. These include canned goods, packaged dry goods, bread & pastries, fresh fruits & vegetables, as well as dairy products. Occasionally, meat, fish, and poultry items are also available.

So far this year, our weekly distribution averages have been impressive, serving over 59 households and impacting more than 160 individuals with 20+ guests taking advantage of the Clothes Closet! Mission Spotlight: East-West

MPC supports various missions around the world and here at home.

This month's Mission Spotlight is East-West

In 1993, East-West was formed to take the gospel to the spiritually darkest places in the world. Over the past 30 years, they have taken the gospel to millions of unreached people.

Currently, East-West is working in 44 nations around the world. Over the last 10 years, East-West's focus has been primarily on multiplying disciples and equipping local leaders so that they might spread the gospel and plant churches among their own people. Utilizing indigenous people to spread the gospel in unreached communities has proven to be a very sustainable basis for sharing the love of Christ.

East-West works with local churches and individuals who want to serve among the nations. Whether for a week or a lifetime, East-West sends short-term missions teams and long-term field workers overseas to share the gospel, make disciples, and plant churches where none currently exist.

Of particular concern at this time are the deteriorating conditions in Cuba. The people have lost faith in their ineffective government. The government cannot provide even the basic services of clean water and electricity consistently. Hygiene and health care have suffered, and food insecurity is increasing. Many Cubans have lost hope and fled to other countries. Among those that remain, there is a great hunger for the gospel and the hope it provides.

God is at work in Cuba through the efforts of East-West. East-West team members have been working with local churches and leaders to share the gospel and distribute desperately needed food, medicine and other supplies.

MPC has supported the mission of East-West for many years. This year we were blessed to be able to provide an additional donation to purchase much needed supplies for the citizens of Cuba.

We are grateful for the work of East-West and look forward to supporting their efforts in the years to come.
