### **Meals on Wheels**



Hello Church! It's been a little while since we've shared information with you about your Meals on Wheels ministry. It's been an eventful year since we transitioned to Aging True.


I'll explain. MPC supports a Meals on Wheels ministry that serves as many as 20 residents daily Monday - Friday in the Mandarin area (32223 and 32257 zip codes), for a lunchtime meal. We currently serve 12 clients. You may recall we transitioned to Aging True, the non-profit federally funded organization to support the national Meals on Wheels program in Duval and Clay Counties, as our food service provider last year. We became a "drop site" for them on October 1, 2023.

We still use an army of volunteers to deliver the meals, a smile and some brief conversation in a routine that now takes about an hour and a half from start to finish. We've lost a few of our faithful volunteers in the last several months and are in need of a couple of new volunteer teams. Currently the third Tuesday of every month is open for a permanent team. We begin the route at the MPC offices on Mandarin Road between 11:30am and 11:45am depending on food arrival, and most of our volunteers deliver just once a month. It's a great volunteer opportunity for retired couples. If you know of someone who might need our services or if you'd like to explore volunteering yourself, please give the church office a call at 904-680-9944 and they will put you in contact with an MPC Meals on Wheels coordinator.

Through the first nine months of 2024, our Daily Bread Food Pantry and Clothes Closet have seen consistently high quest visitation rates. Our dedicated volunteers continue their weekly distribution of **three** grocery bags filled with a variety of items. These include canned goods, packaged dry goods, bread & pastries, fresh fruits & vegetables, as well as dairy products. Occasionally, meat, fish, and poultry items are also available.

So far this year, our weekly distribution averages have been impressive, serving over 58 households and impacting more than 135 individuals with 20+ guests taking advantage of the Clothes Closet! 

MPC supports various missions around the world and here at home. This month's Mission Spotlight is Seamark Ranch.

Seamark Ranch is a nurturing Christian home and family system that gives children from families in crisis the tools they need for a brighter future. Through a family home model, a specialized residential school, and the lessons of life in a working farm community, Seamark Ranch provides the ideal setting for love, stabilization, healing, education, and empowerment.

Seamark Ranch provides services to children and families in crisis. Our residents are foster care children and private placements who have experienced life-altering abuse and neglect at a young age. We currently have six loving homes and families to serve the young people in our program. We also provide parenting classes and counseling to their family members to support reunification when that is an option.

Our programs not only meet residents' basic needs, but also provide mental wellbeing services, academic instruction, spiritual training, and workforce development. The most rewarding part of our work is witnessing the transformation in our residents. As a long-term placement program, we have supported over 180 children and families through the most challenging times of their lives. We celebrate the growth that all of our children have experienced and look forward to serving more children and their families in the future, inspiring hope and a brighter future.

Seamark Ranch's programs have received numerous awards. We are accredited by the Council on Accreditation and maintain licensure with the Department of Children and Families.
